#### Prayer Life - review

#### Hebrews 10:19-22

Therefore, brothers and sisters, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body, and since we have a great priest over the house of God, let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water.

#### John 15:7 NLT

But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!

#### 1 John 5:14-15 NLT

And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. <sup>15</sup> And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for.

## I John 5:14-15 amp

And this is the confidence (the assurance, the privilege of boldness) which we have in Him: [we are sure] that if we ask anything (make any request) according to His will (in agreement with His own plan), He listens to *and* hears us. And if (since) we [positively] know that He listens to us in whatever we ask, we also know [with settled and absolute knowledge] that we have [granted us as our present possessions] the requests made of Him.

- Faith is the fuel that prayer runs on.
- Faith begins where the will of God is known.
- His Word is His Will.

#### Hebrews 11:1 amp

Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

#### Hebrews 11:1 nlt

Faith is the confidence that what we hope for will actually happen; it gives us assurance about things we cannot see.

#### Hebrews 11:1 voice

Faith is the assurance of things you have hoped for, the absolute conviction that there are realities you've never seen.

# John 15:7

But if you remain in me and my words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted!

#### Romans 10:17

So then faith *comes* by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

- It's not just *The Word* that makes a difference. *My Words* also make a difference.
- What happens outside of the prayer room affects the prayer room.

- 1.) Does Your Heart Condemn You?
- 2 Timothy 2:21 nlt

If you keep yourself pure, you will be a special utensil for honorable use. Your life will be clean, and you will be ready for the Master to use you for every good work.

#### Hebrews 10:22

let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience

2.) What are you thinking?

Philippians 4:6-8

Don't be anxious about things; instead, pray. Pray about everything. He longs to hear your requests, so talk to God about your needs and be thankful for what has come. And know that the peace of God (a peace that is beyond any and all of our human understanding) will stand watch over your hearts

and minds in Jesus, the Anointed One. Finally, brothers and sisters, fill your minds with beauty and truth. Meditate on whatever is honorable, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is good, whatever is virtuous and praiseworthy. Keep to the script: whatever you learned and received and heard and saw in me—do it—and the God of peace will walk with you.

#### 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 voice

The weapons of the war we're fighting are not of this world but are powered by God and effective at tearing down the strongholds erected against His truth. We are demolishing arguments and ideas, every high-and-mighty philosophy that pits itself against the knowledge of the one true God. We are taking prisoners of every thought, every emotion, and subduing them into obedience to the Anointed One.

#### 2 Corinthians 10:4-5 amp

For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before God for the overthrow and destruction of strongholds, [Inasmuch as we] refute arguments and theories and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God; and we lead every thought and purpose away captive into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed One)

3.) He hears more than you think

Malachi 3:16 nlt

Then those who feared the LORD spoke with each other, and the LORD listened to what they said.

Jeremiah 8:6

I listen to their conversations and don't hear a word of truth.

- Our words outside of the prayer room count.
- He doesn't start listening with, "Dear Heavenly Father" and stop as soon as we say, "Amen!"
- What do my conversations look like?

Prayer starts and ends with Him.

- Based on the Word of God.
- Based on faith.
- Through our mouths back to Him.
- He answers.

- His Word and His promises are His potential for our lives. We must align ourselves up with Him.
- We do this with our words speaking His Word.
- That is prayer He answers.
